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Enter the abstract of your paper here (should not exceed 250 words). Use 10 point Times New Roman and single-line spacing throughout.

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Use 1 column for the body. Use 12 point Times New Roman and single-line spacing throughout. Figures and table should be placed as close as possible to where they are mentioned in the text. First-level headings state the table or figure number. All the tables and images should be embedded into the file and sized appropriately. Divide your article into clearly defined, centered:

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Maximum page for the entire article (from first page until references) is 15 pages.

APPENDIX

The appendix should immediately follow the body of the paper and precede the references.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS

Collate acknowledgements in a separate section at the end of the article before the references.

REFERENCES

References must be in English and arranged first alphabetically by author's last name and then sorted chronologically if necessary. Use <u>APA style (7th edition)</u> and include digital object identifiers (DOIs) if they have been assigned to the content. References do not exceed beyond 7 years back with 80% journal articles and 20% other sources such as books, news articles, etc.
